

# The next pages have a series of printable dice

Print them off on different coloured card if possible. This means that we can refer to them as, for example, "your red dice or blue dice."

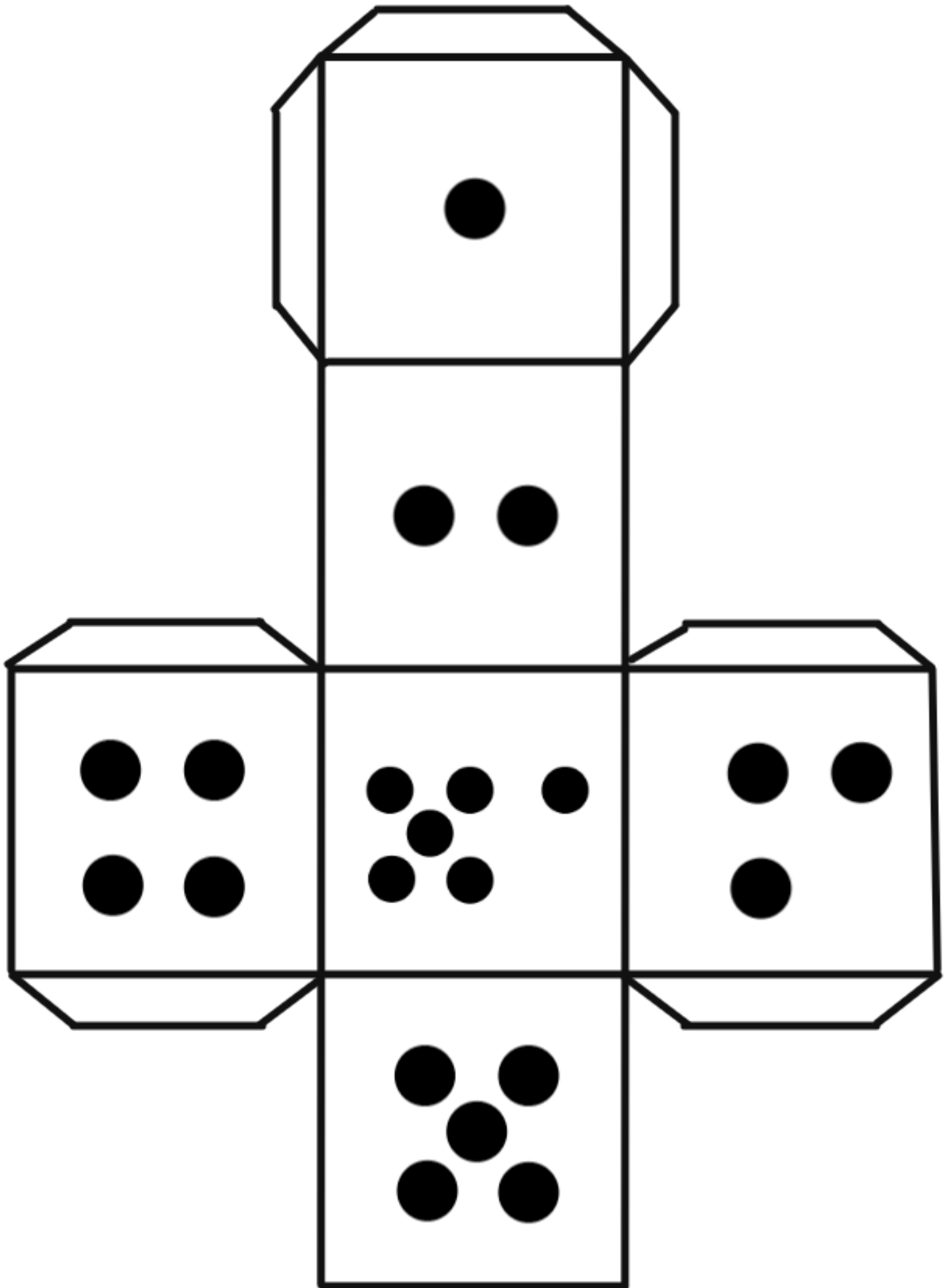
**There is no need to print them all off at the start, just print and make 2 different ones so we can start to use them in the first lesson.**

They all have slightly different sets of numbers on them, between zero and ten.

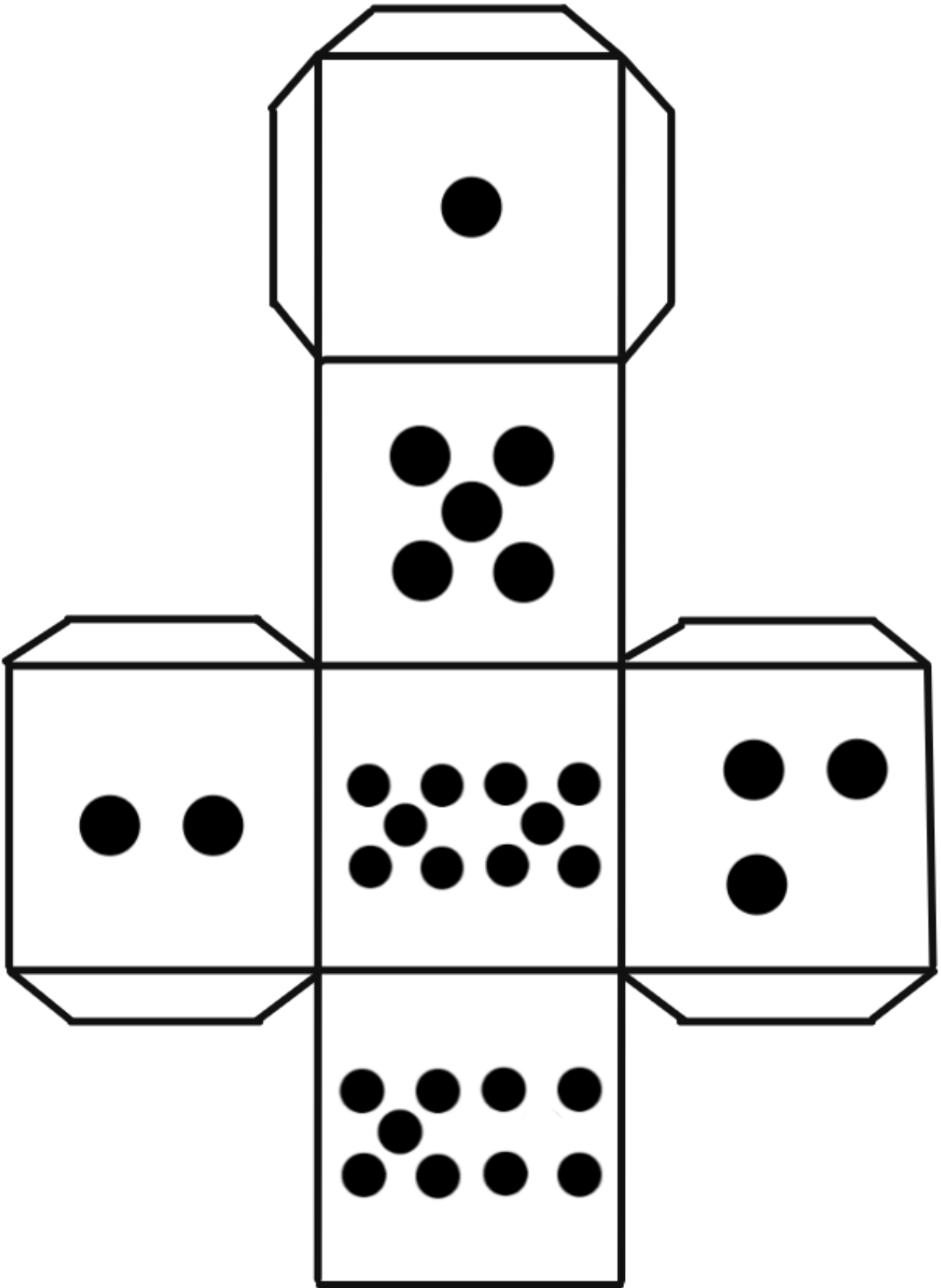
The final dice gives us 1-12. This is used for timestables work.

I recommend using PVA glue to seal the edges and make it more sturdy.

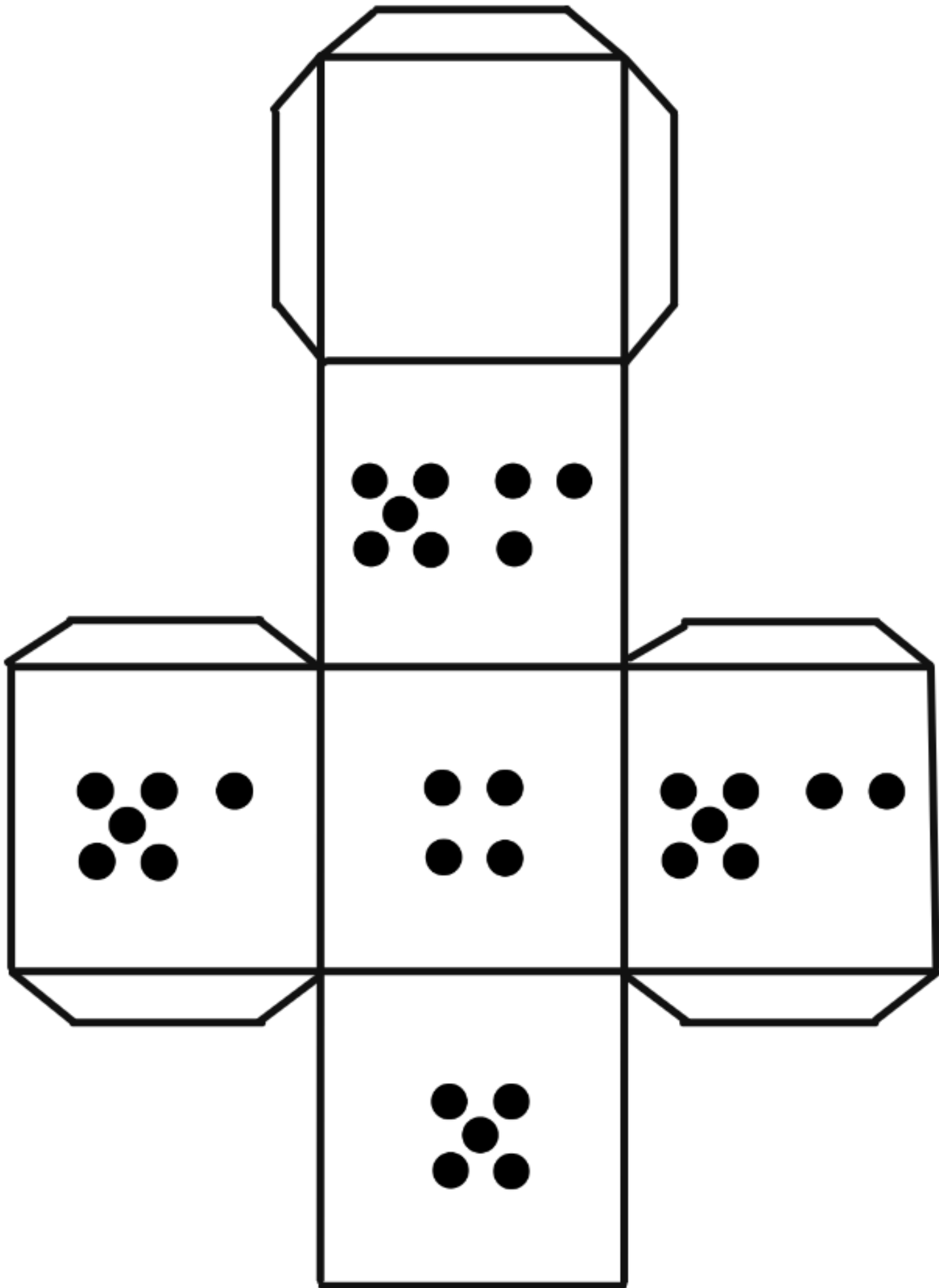




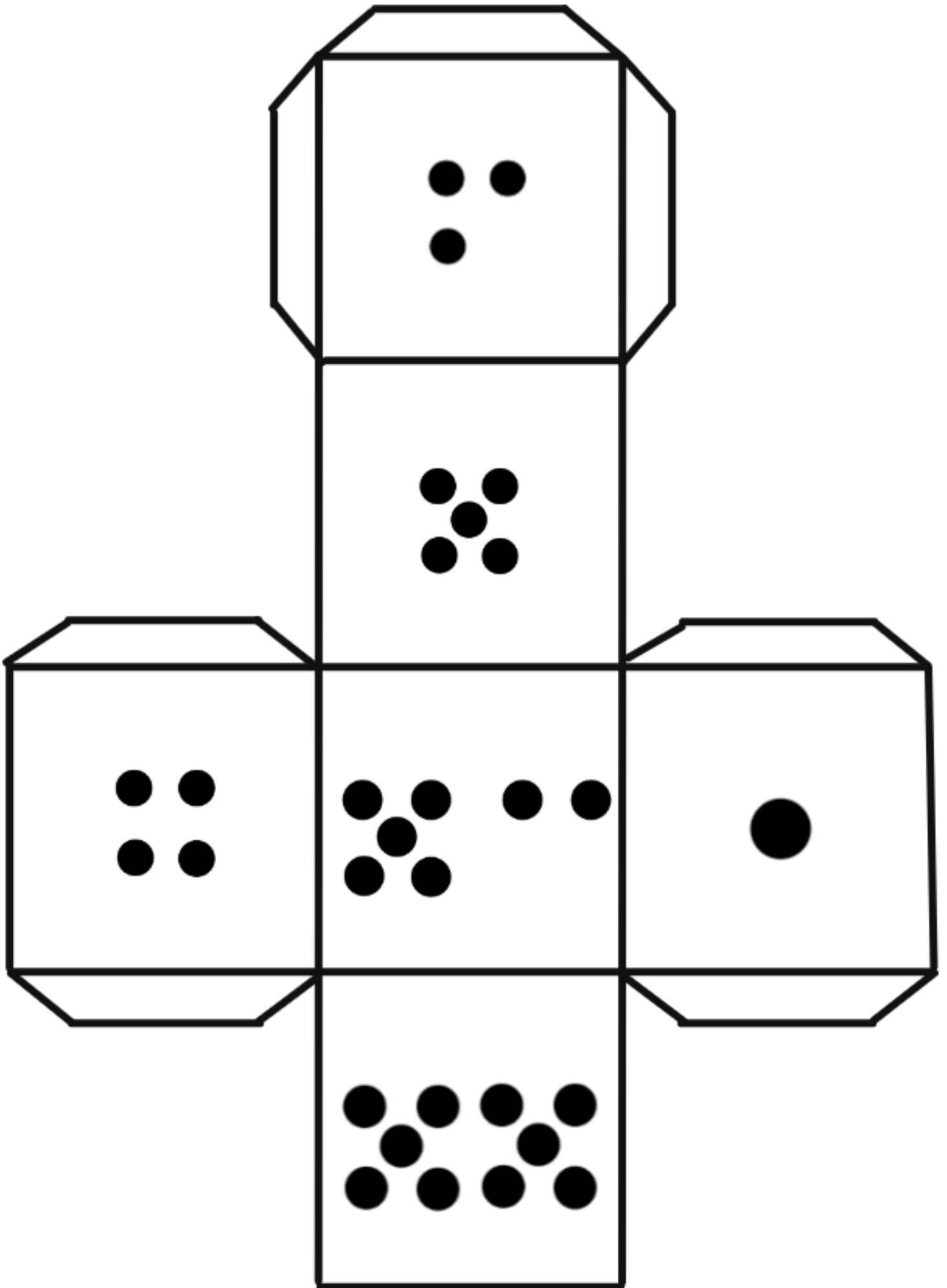

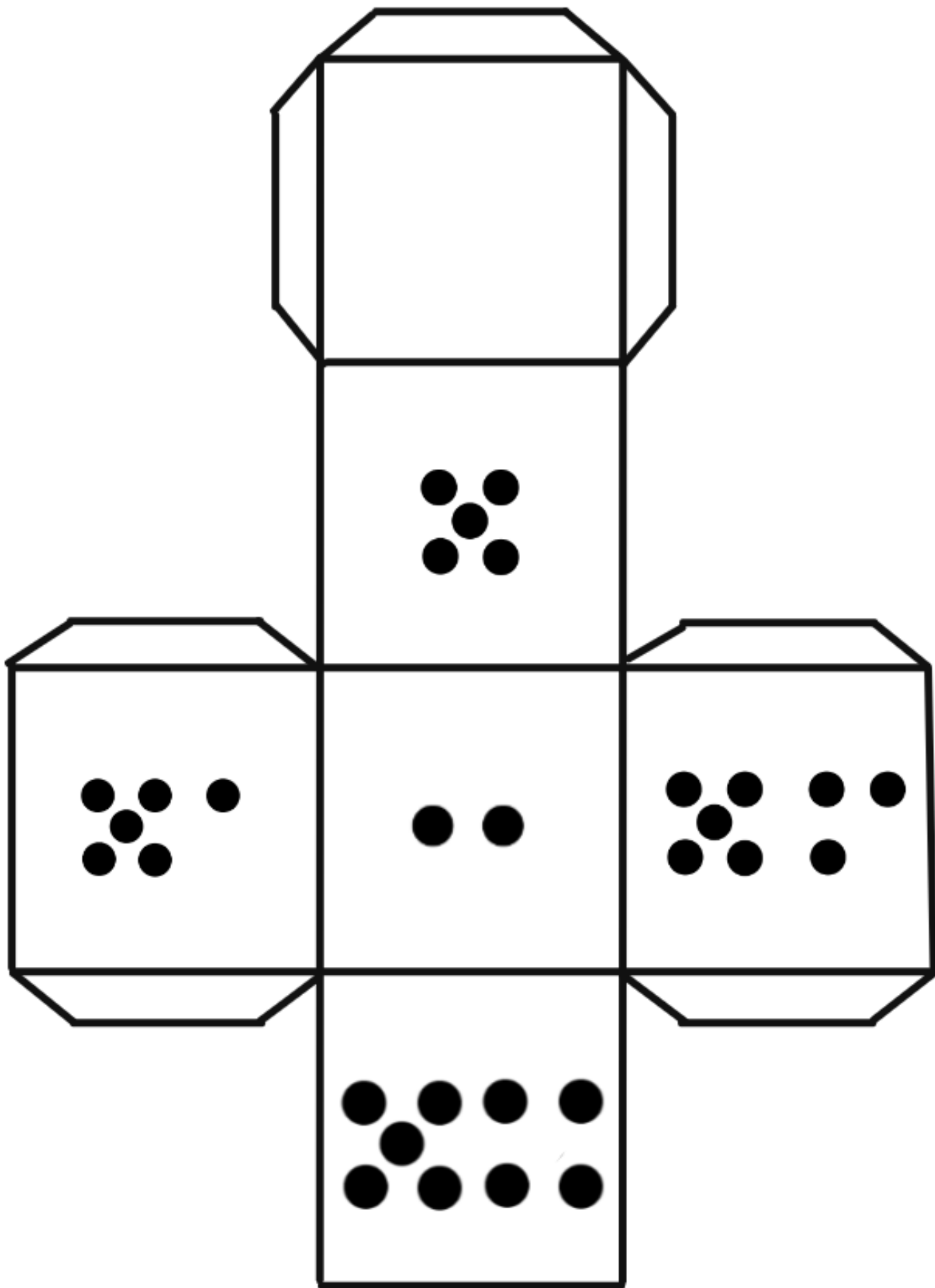

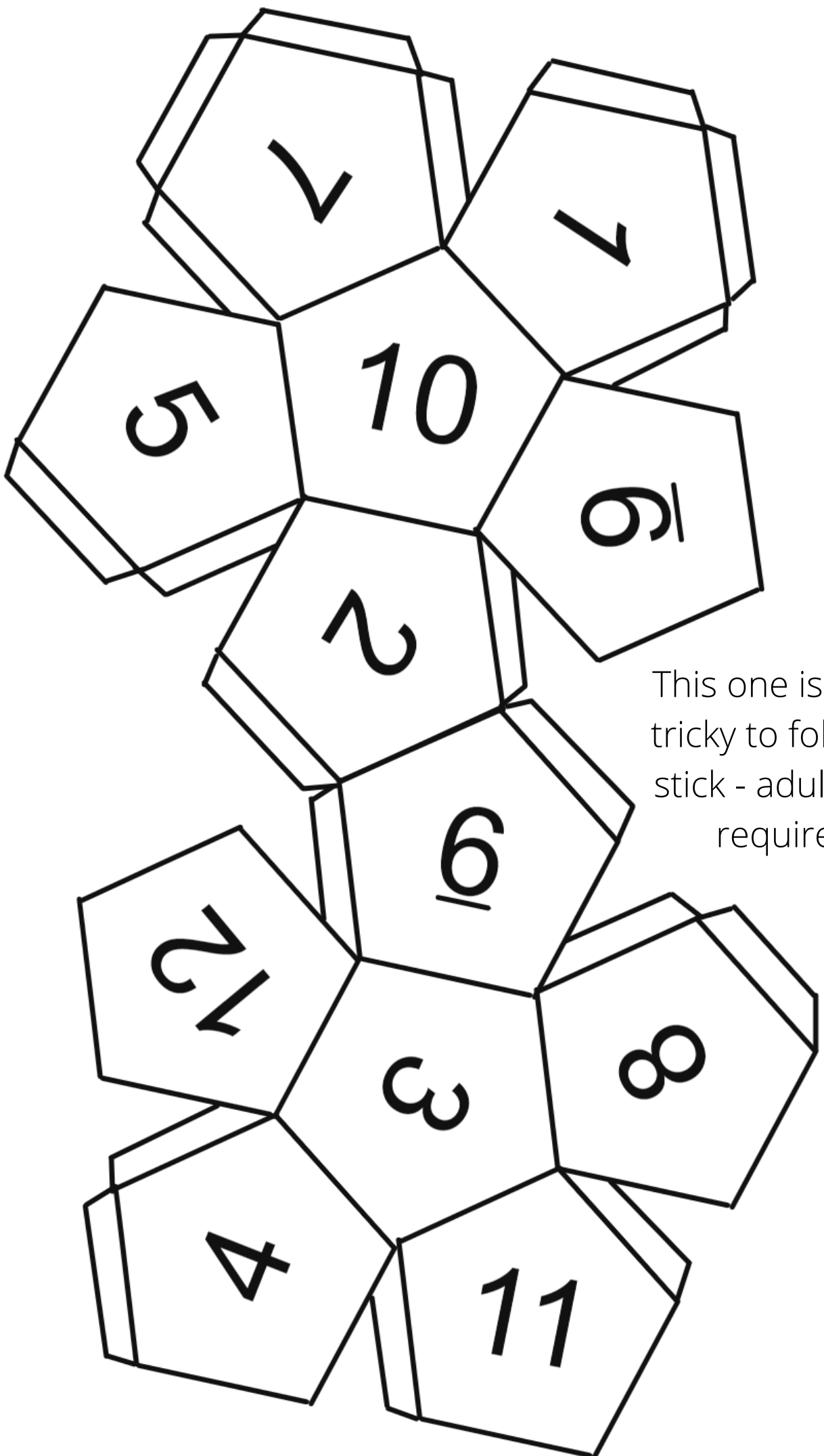
